

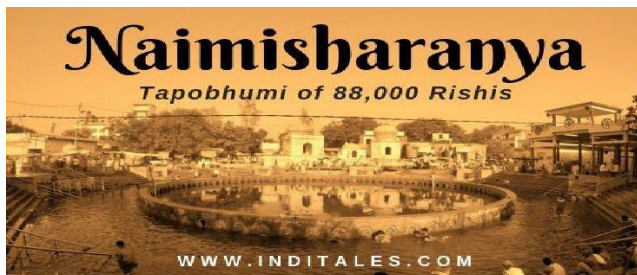

NAIMISARAN - AYODHYA - PRAYAGRAJ - VARANASI - GAYA - BODHGAYA 5 NIGHTS / 6 DAYS

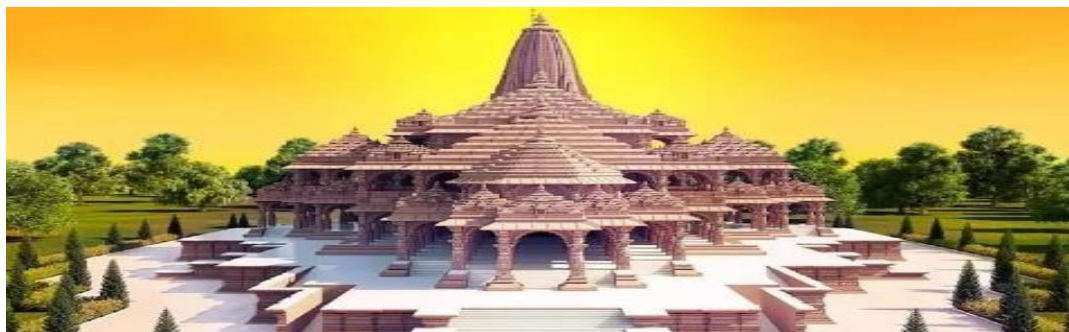
DAY 01:- LUCKNOW ARRIVAL -NAIMISARAN-LUCKNOW

Pick-up Airport at 9:30 am then proceed Naimisharanyam approx 110 kms/ 2 hours journey it is renowned from the time of Satya Yuga. The place is unique owing to the belief that it is the land where the pantheon of 33 Hindu God & Goddesses reside Upon arrival visit Chakra tirtha, Vyas Gaddi, Hanuman Garhi, Pandav Kila, Dawpuri Mandir, Balaji Mandir later proceed to Lucknow approx 90 kms / 2 .30 hours. Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel.



DAY 02 :- LUCKNOW- AYODHYA- PRAYAGRAJ

After breakfast check out hotel going to Ayodhya approx 170 Km./ Approx 4.30 Hours . Ayodhya also Known as Saket a Legendary Spiritual Center on the Bank of River Saryu. Birth birthplace of Lord Rama. Upon arrival, check-in to your hotel. After Lunch proceed to visit Hanuman Garhi dedicated to Lord Hanuman. Kanak Bhawanis dedicated to Lord Ram and his divine consort Goddess Sita. In evening attend Aarti performed on the banks of Sarayu river . Then proceed to Prayagraj check in hotel & take Dinner Night stay at Prayagraj.



DAY 03 :- PRAYAGRAJ-VARANASI (VIA-VIDCHYAL)

After breakfast Check out hotel. Allahabad is also known as Prayag. It is the second-oldest city in India situated at confluence of Ganga, Yamuna & Saraswathi river also known as Triveni Sangam. Bade Hanuman Ji Temple is also known as 'Lete Hanuman' Mandir is dedicated to the Lord Hanuman. It is closed to Allahabad fort. The statue of Lord Hanuman in Sleeping posture. In this posture, this is the only temple in whole India. Later proceed to Sangam. And The Ghats confluence of holy Rivers Ganga, Yamuna and Saraswathi. Return to the Varanasi via Vindhyachal Shaktipith Darshan. Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel in Varanasi.

**DAY 04:- VARANASI-GAYA- VARANASI**

Early morning proceed for Gaya Vishnu Pad temple (Vishnupada Mandir is an ancient temple dedicated to Lord Vishnu. Many people come here to perform rituals on Falgu river.) Back to Hotel for breakfast drive to Varanasi. Check in hotel and take dinner. Night stay.



DAY 05:- VARANASI LOCAL SITESEEING

Early morning take a boat ride along the great Ganges, known locally as Mother Ganga- India's most sacred river. Magnificent view during the sunrise time when hundreds of people are worshipping and taking a bath. During boat ride visit all the famous Ghats of Varanasi including the famous Manikarnika Ghat where cremations take place round the clock. Later proceed to visit Kashi Vishwanath temple one of the twelve Jyotirlingas dedicated to Lord Shiva. Later visit Annapurna temple is dedicated to the Annapurna. . Later return back to the hotel. In the evening proceed to Dashashwamedh Ghat. No vehicle zone guest have to walk or take a rickshaw to reach Dashashwamedh Ghat. witness Aarti ceremony at the ghat. the whole event takes around 45 minutes. Return to the hotel . Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel.

**DAY 06:- VARANASI-DEPARTURE**

After breakfast check out from the hotel & transfer to schedule departure destination.
