8 NIGHTS / 9 DAYS



VISIT : Lima • Cusco • Sacred Valley • Aguas Calientes • Puno

DAY 1 Lima

- ⇒ Arrive at Lima Airport.
- ⇒ A transportation service and a guide will pick you up from the airport at the scheduled time to transfer you to your hotel in Lima.
- ⇒ The Peruvian capital is a modern metropolis full of history, undergoing an exciting cultural and economic change process.
- ⇒ **Overnight stay in Lima**

DAY 2 Lima

- ⇒ Full-day tour of Lima (San Francisco, Casa Aliaga) and Larco Herrera Museum
- ⇒ Your tour starts downtown, where you will visit the Aliaga House, an ancient viceregal house delivered by Francisco Pizarro to one of his captains (Jerónimo de Aliaga) after the

foundation of the city. There you can see (panoramic view) the Presidential Palace, the Archbishops Palace and the Lima Cathedral. Next, you will go to Saint Francis Church and you will go to the Pueblo Libre district to visit the Larco Museum, located in the same district, founded by Rafael Larco Hoyle in 1926. The museum, located inside a viceregal mansion built on a pre-Columbian pyramid of the 7th century, shows the most complete pre-Hispanic collection of gold and silver artifacts as well as pieces of erotic art.

⇒ **Overnight stay in Lima**

DAY 3 Lima – Cusco – Sacred Valley

- ⇒ **Check out** and proceed to the airport to board a **flight for Cusco**

- ⇒ **Full-day tour to Chinchero, Ollantaytambo fortress and Living Museum of Yucay**
- ⇒ During the morning, you are picked up from Cusco airport to visit the town of Chinchero, a traditional Cusco urban center located at an elevated point with a beautiful view of the valley. Then, you are transferred from **Ollantaytambo** to the Living Museum of **Yucay**, a center of Andean traditions and interpretations, where demonstrations of the elaboration of textile work, adobe, pottery and silverware are carried out in the same way in which they used to in antiquity; an original recreation of Inca traditions.
- ⇒ At the end of this activity, you are transferred back to your hotel and **check in** at the hotel.
- ⇒ **Overnight stay in Sacred Valley**

DAY 4 Sacred Valley

- ⇒ **Full-day tour to Maras and Moray**
- ⇒ Your day will begin with a tour of approximately an hour and a half to the archaeological sites of **Moray and Maras**. The archaeological remains of Moray consist of mysterious concentric circular terraces that for some scholars would be an agricultural research center. On the other hand, Maras is a surreal sight. It is an impressive complex of salt mining. After the tour return to your hotel.
- ⇒ **Overnight stay in Sacred Valley**

DAY 5 Sacred Valley – Aguas Calientes – Cusco

- ⇒ **Full day tour to Machu Picchu**
- ⇒ A transportation service and a guide for assistance till the station will pick you up from your hotel in Urubamba at preset time to drive you to the Ollantaytambo train station.
- ⇒ On the outward journey, board PeruRail's Vistadome service train that will take you from **Ollantaytambo station to Machu Picchu**. (Aguas Calientes)
- ⇒ Your journey to Machu Picchu begins with a train ride to the town of Aguas Calientes, where you will find a handicraft market, restaurants and accommodation of different categories. At the end of the tour, return by PeruRail's Vistadome service train from Aguas Calientes to the Ollantaytambo train station and then to Cusco and the hotel.
- ⇒ Schedules will be previously coordinated.
- ⇒ **Overnight stay in Sacred Valley**

DAY 6 Cusco

- ⇒ **Half-day tour to the city of Cusco with a visit to Coricancha,**

**Cathedral,
Sacsayhuaman,
Quenqo, Pucara
and
Tambomachay .**



- ⇒ Enjoy a guided tour of this charming city, which was the capital of the Inca Empire. The tour begins with a visit to the Convent of Santo Domingo, which was built over the Inca temple of Coricancha, one of the most important precincts dedicated to the cult of the sun. Next, visit the Cathedral, the most imposing monument in the Plaza de Armas. Continue the tour to Puka Pukara, the "red fort" in Quechua; an architectural complex of supposed military use, with multiple environments, plazas, baths, aqueducts and towers. At the end of the tour, return to your hotel.
- ⇒ **Overnight stay in Cusco**

DAY 7 Cusco – Puno

- ⇒ **Full-day shared tour from Cusco to Puno (From Min 2 to Min 8)**
- ⇒ To begin our trip from Cusco to Puno, board the touristic bus that will take you through the wonderful Andes scenery. First, stop in **Andahuaylillas**, a town located 40 kilometers from Cusco that has as its main attraction the Church of Andahuaylillas, nicknamed the 'Sistine Chapel of America', due to the impressive art found in it.
- ⇒ Then, arrive at the town of Pucara, where the Pucara Lithic Museum is located. Finally, arrive in the city of Puno and **check in**. Touristic transportation from Cusco to Puno with a guide.
- ⇒ **Overnight stay in Puno**



MEALS : Breakfast

DAY 8 Puno

- ⇒ **Full-day tour to Uros and Taquile Islands**
- ⇒ Transfer to the lacustrine port of Puno, where a boat takes you to the floating island of the Uros. The Uros are an ancestral society that populates a series of artificial islands built with the totora plant, a type of reed that grows in the Titikaka lake. There they build their houses, also from totora. After a journey of an hour and a half, continue your trip to the island of Taquile. This island was part of the Inca Empire and its inhabitants speak Quechua. Once there, receive a briefing about the island.
- ⇒ **Overnight stay in Puno**

DAY 9 Depart Puno

- ⇒ **Check out** and transportation service will take you from the selected hotel to Puno airport, and a representative will assist you along the way.
